CENTER POINT INC.'S RWC PROGRAM

Center Point, Inc. operates the Residential Women with Children Treatment Program in order to assist those in need of an intensive highly structured treatment environment. The Program admits pregnant women on a priority basis as a matter of established preference.

The program offers a variable stay from 3 to 6 months, clients are assessed for additional treatment needs during the course of treatment. All treatment is based on the clients voluntary agreement for placement. Additional assessments are completed regarding the client's clinical, mental health, legal, family, and medical needs. Based on the intake interview and assessments, the client and the clinical team mutually develop an individualized treatment plan which will guide the clients treatment experience.

The Adult Residential Treatment provides cognitive, behavioral, educational, vocational, and peer support interventions that promote pro-social adaptation to life without drugs and alcohol.

PREPARING FOR POSITIVE RE-ENTRY INTO SOCIETY

Center Point offers a range of rehabilitative services that promote pro-social development, employability, family and inter-personal stability, successful community reintegration, and a clean and sober life style. Services include:

CENTER POINT DELIVERS

Center Point operates the 40-bed treatment facility in San Rafael, California. This program offers integrated treatment for women with children with priority admission for pregnant women. The treatment and training curriculum emphasizes the development of skills that assist participants in successful community reintegration, including social and cognitive skill building, vocational preparation, relapse prevention, community integration, and continuing care planning. Length of treatment is based on individualized assessed need. Continuing Care services provide critical social and clinical support after program completion.

CONTINUING CARE

Continuing Care services are initiated when participants complete residential or intensive outpatient programs. Weekly groups provide an on-going supportive forum that addresses re-entry issues and concerns. Continuing Care fosters the development of a stable peer support network (including AA & NA), recovery management skills, and provides continuing supportive services.
